India

It is impossible for us to fully understand how and why God works the way He does. Despite our best efforts to be obedient to what we believe to be His leading, He sometimes closes a door. As most of you are aware, according to our plans, I (Dan) was to be in India right now. However, for the second time, my visa to travel to India was denied and the trip had to be cancelled. It appears that I have



been banned from entering India and may never be able to travel there because of my history as a pastor and missionary. Please pray, as this is a heartbreaking development. How can you lead an oversea ministries in a country you cannot visit? God has the answer to that question and we trust He will reveal it to us in His timing. This has truly given me a greater appreciation for the words of the Apostle Paul in I Thessalonians 2:18, "Wherefore we would have come unto you, even I Paul, once and again; but Satan hindered us." I believe that the Apostle Paul's letters to the Church in Thessalonica have had a greater impact for the gospel than if he had been able to visit in person, and I trust that God has a similar plan with us in India.

One of our Bible Colleges in India, where I was to be ministering this week, has 7 graduates who have answered the call to church planting in villages that are in desperate need of the gospel. One hundred dollars per month would help each of them meet their personal and ministry needs as they go out into these villages with the gospel of Jesus Christ. Would you consider supporting one of these graduates?

2025 Ministry Travel Plans

My role as International Director requires a considerable amount of international travel. I thank the Lord and you, our faithful supporters, that up to this point I have had the necessary funds to cover travel expenses. Please pray for God's continued provision. Here is a list of my already scheduled trips for 2025. A trip to West Africa could also be added to my itinerary this year.

- April 30—May 9: Medical missions trip to Peru
 (May also visit Argentina as part of this trip, as WOTBM is considering Argentina as a new mission field)
- July 11—26: Mission teams and leadership training in the Dominican Republic
- October 1—12: Pastor and Chaplain training in Kenya, Africa
- **November 11—24:** Mission team and celebrating 50th Anniversary of the Jacagua Church (Jacagua Church was the first church planted by my parents in the Dominican Republic)

Mission Project in Liberia, West Africa

One of our missionaries in Liberia is in need of a roof for this new church building. Once they have a roof on the building, they can begin to hold services in it. Yes, they will worship God without windows, doors, or concrete floor. However, protection from the elements is critical for them to use this building. Can you help with this project? Do you know of a group of builders that would be willing to spend a week in Liberia and put up some wooden trusses and a metal roof so that this congregation can begin to use it? Would you be willing to give a one-time donation towards this project? The estimated cost of the materials for this project is \$10,000 U.S. dollars.
